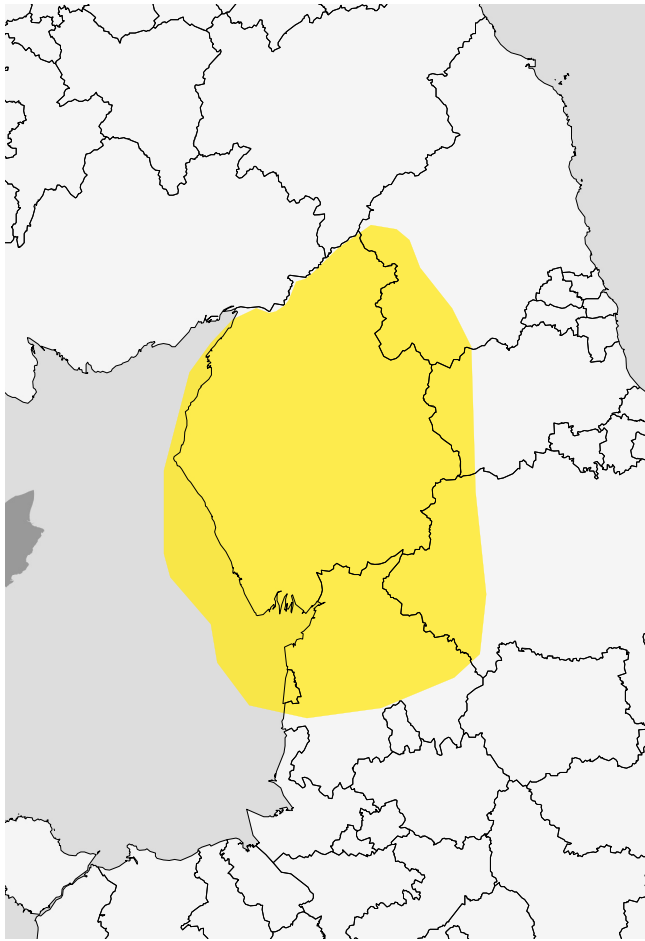

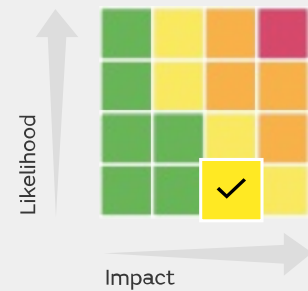
Heavy rain will result in some flooding and travel disruption


What to expect

- There is a small chance that homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Where flooding occurs, there is a slight chance of delays or cancellations to train and bus services
- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- There is a small chance that some communities become cut off by flooded roads
- There is a slight chance of power cuts and loss of other services to some homes and businesses

Further details

Spells of heavy rain will affect parts of northern England on Wednesday, especially during the afternoon and evening. 20 to 40 mm is likely quite widely with as much as 50 to 80 mm in a few places, mainly across hilly parts of Cumbria. The rain will clear away southeastwards on Wednesday night and into Thursday morning.
